3. I will ensure that I have appropriate licenses for all data I am accessing, that I am abiding by any conditions of the license, and that the licenses are up to date.
4. I will handle all data and other resources in such a way as to protect myself, my department, and the London School of Economics from any legal challenge or loss of reputation.
5. I will not allow any other person access to data or licensed resources unless they have a valid license, and I have permission to pass the data to them.
6. If there is a need for me to hold or process personal or sensitive data, I will inform my centre manager.
